ICD-10 Diagnosis Coding Education and Instruction for Home Health Agencies

Beginning January 1, 2020, Home Health Agencies will implement the most significant change in Medicare Part A payments in decades with the Patient Driven Groupings Model (PDGM).

With PDGM, the focus will shift from volume of services to patient need with verifiable patient-specific characteristics, treatments, and ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes will drive the Home Health Agency payment.
